

Loading Cassettes & Battery

· Slide front cover down and remove it completely.

Insert 2 AAA batteries into battery compartment.

 To load minicassette, move Thumb Control to STOP position. Insert minicassette with side #1 face up; edge of cassette containing exposed tape should face left.

Recording Dictation

· Disengage Security Lock.

· Slide Thumb Control up to RECORD position, Record LED will light.
